"The alumni talked about their paths after graduation, offered advice and inspired an audience of 50 current students," Department Chair Sue Young said. 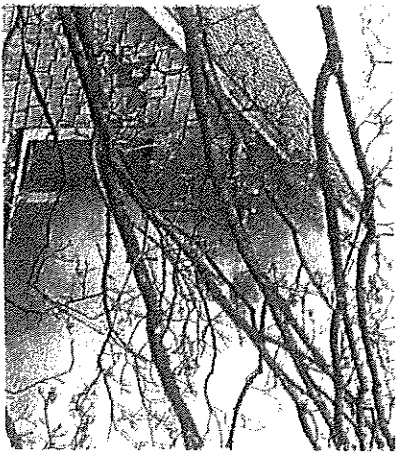

# 800 hit Workforce job fair in Elmira

Matt Glynn wants to provide for his family; Nerissa Grzybowski wants to get her foot in the door; and Brian Magee wants to find something better.

The three Twin Tiers residents were among approximately 800 job-seekers—estimated by CCS Workforce's Sue Carpenter—who attended Chemung-Schuyler-Steuken Workforce's annual regional job fair Tuesday at Elmira College's Murray Athletic Center.

"I'm looking to get my foot in the door at a lab, and I really want to get a serology job," said Grzybowski, of Corning, a recent University of Florida graduate. "I have a lot of theory knowledge; now, I'm just trying to find a place to experience it."

Job seekers used the opportunity to make connections with employers who they might not otherwise meet in person. "This job fair provides a face-to-face

interaction," CCS Workforce representative Jill Koski said. "You can't just walk into an employer's office and say 'Hi,' so this provides a way for job-seekers to do that."

Many of the more desired positions were entry-level, Koski said.

"I'm looking for a career, not a job," said Glynn, of Elmira. "I want to help out with my family and provide for them."

Magee found help writing his résumé. "I'm just trying to find something better than what I'm doing now," Magee, of Horseheads, said as he focused on the construction field.

Sage Peake, an employment specialist at Cayuga Medical Center in Ithaca, reserved a booth at the fair, hoping to fill several positions—from registered nurses to support staff. "I've seen a lot of foot-in-the-door and information technology applicants," Peake said after collecting approximately 25 résumés. "So many people have transferable skills that can apply to other jobs."
