

Synopsis: Another invasive species has lept into New York. That's right – Asian jumping worms, which made it into the southern U.S. a century ago, are now turning up in New York State soil. They don't exactly "jump," but they wriggle rapidly compared to the average American earthworm – enough to briefly leap maybe an inch off the ground. They also have a white band near the front of their body that makes them stand out. The invasive species is bad news, too. Unlike helpful earthworms, this variety doesn't burrow deep into soil, but gobbles surface nutrients, leaving rich soil barren. That harms native plants and worms, in turn impacting reptiles and birds. The state DEC asks residents to report any jumping worm sightings to them.
