KPHT provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Breast Cancer Awareness: Rochelle spoke with Nick on the Cancer facility at St. Mary Corwin Hospital and the process for men and women with every aspect of their journey from start to surgery to hopefully cure and follow up for breast cancer patients..Also how their state of the art facility is the hub for Southern Colorado.
- Diabetes: Lori spoke on the leading causes of diabetes and how the disease effects more people in Southern Colorado due to the higher Hispanic population...A healthier diet for all and where you can get tested. Also how to live a healthy life with diabetes...
