KPHT provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- American Heart Association: Paula talked about the impact of heart related disease on our Nation and Local Community. We discussed the importance of nutrition and exercise for a heart healthy life. Warning signs and what to do in a heart related emergency. And the upcoming Heart Ball to benefit the American Heart Association.
- CDOT Construction on I-25: A 15 mile stretch of I-25 in the northern half of Colorado Springs and El Paso County will be expanded to three lanes in each direction. We discussed the construction timetable, changes to the highway and it's interchanges and where listeners can find construction related information.
- Chinese Population in Colorado Springs: Spoke with Mali regarding the Chinese population in Southern Colorado, how it has grown, special needs of the community and the up-coming Chinese New Years Celebration in Colorado Springs.
- Colorado Springs Utilities: Colorado is in the second year of severe drought conditions, snow pack and annual rain fall levels are far below normal. Ann discussed the impact the shrinking water supply will have on usage this coming summer. We talked about a two day a week watering schedule. Conservation and Xeriscape tips for home owners and where to get help and information.
- Diocese of Colorado Springs: We discussed the circumstances surrounding the selection of a new Pope. The history and precedence that were involved and the structure of the selection process. We also discussed the current needs of the Catholic Church and how a new Pope might impact those needs.
- El Paso County Commissioner: Sallie discussed the ongoing concern in the county for the Waldo Canyon burn area and the county's involvement in recovery both physically and monetarily. City and County cooperation on a number of projects

We also posted a number of related information links on the station web sites in addition to emergency numbers and contacts.
- Safe Passage: Spoke to Wilene about the identification of and treatment for child abuse victims. Last year there were over 11,000 reports of abuse or neglect of Children.
