KPHT provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Breakfast of Champions Fundraiser:** Peak Vista Community Health Centers is a non-profit Federally Qualified Health Center dedicated to providing premier medical, dental and behavioral healthcare in a collaborative setting for people of all ages. Peak Vista serves over 80,000 patients, through 25 outpatient centers, in Colorado's Pikes Peak and East Central Plains regions and through the Ronald McDonald care mobile. We discussed who qualifies for Peak Vista Services, what services they provide and how to apply. Randy also spoke of the search for a new director at the Peak Vista Foundation and the up coming Breakfast of Champions fund raiser.
- **Child Abuse Advocate:** CASA of the Pikes Peak Region is a nonprofit organization that trains and supervises volunteers to represent the best interests of victims of child abuse, neglect, and severe domestic conflict. CASA volunteers are appointed by judges to be a voice for these children in court and in the community. The desired result is that children be placed in safe, loving homes where they can thrive. Trudy spoke of CASA (tm)s history, the need in our community, services provides, statistics of abuse in the Pikes Peak region and individuals come to the program.
- **Childrens Healthcare:** Newborn Hope raises funds and supports programs for the advancement of maternal, fetal and neonatal healthcare and well being of unborn babies at risk of premature birth. In an average week in Colorado 158 babies are born preterm. 23 babies are born very preterm. Prematurity is the leading cause of death in newborns in Colorado. Prematurity is the leading contributor to lifelong disabilities for children including developmental delays, chronic respiratory problems, vision & hearing problems and loss. National annual cost of providing medical care for premature babies is \$13.6 billion. Jenny spoke of how they help and how families in need can reach out for help.
- **Community Bases Resources:** Tri-Lakes Cares is a community based, volunteer supported, resource center whose purpose is to improve people (tm)s lives through emergency, self-sufficiency and relief programs

kitchens and shelters) that provide food to those in need throughout 52,000 square miles of Southern Colorado. - **Pikes Peak Red Cross:** The Red Cross helps individuals and communities prepare for, respond to and recover from disasters; Teach lifesaving skills to tens of thousands of individuals; Provide transportation for the critically ill and elderly and; Offer support to U.S. service members and their families in Colorado. And provide lifesaving information to immigrant and migrant communities, promote international Humanitarian Law and reconnect families separated by war or disaster.
- **Pikes Peak YMCA:** Over the last 135 years, the YMCA has grown to include branch locations throughout the Pikes Peak Region and offsite locations at schools and neighborhood centers to reach over 125,000 people each year. Through partnerships and community involvement the YMCA is reaching out in new ways to build strong kids, strong families, and strong communities. We spoke to Carrie about neighborhood involvement, the many programs the Y offers to its (tm)s members, a recent change in leadership and their recent partnership with the Penrose St Francis healthcare system to create the new Tri Lakes Health Care Pavilion.
- **Programs For Low Income Families:** For 50 years, REACH has been at the forefront of providing supportive services designed to enhance the quality of life for the lower-income population of the Pikes Peak Region. Our self-sufficiency programs have expanded over the years to include emergency services, a long-term case intensive job skills/educational enhancement program, and two matched savings programs for self-sufficiency asset acquisition " one for adults and one for at-risk youths
- **Senior Healthcare:** Silver Key serves in partnership with their stakeholders to support quality of life for seniors - allowing them the choice of safely aging in place with dignity and independence. Programs include evaluation, transportation, meals on wheels and case management.
