## **KVII PUBLIC SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY 1<sup>ST</sup> QUARTER 2016**

**KVII addressed the needs of the community through a variety of outreach activities and sponsorships of charitable events and fundraisers.**

Our Chief Meteorologist was busy with the following in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2016

Thursday, January 28 - Installed a new SchoolNet site at Grandview-Hopkins ISD (7 miles NE of Groom). I also spoke to the students (74 total) about the weather station, how it worked, what instruments it has and what they do. I then answered weather questions from the kids and the entire presentation took about 40 minutes.

2. Tuesday, February 16 - 7pm - Read to a group of 2nd graders at Woodlands Elementary here in Amarillo. They had a "campfire reading" event. Read a Dr. Seuss book, "Oh Say, Can you say, What's the Weather Today". There were about 40 students total (parents were there as well).

3. Wednesday, February 17 - 3:30pm - Spoke for about 40 minutes to the Greenways Intermediate School, "Science Club". This group included 6-8 graders and had 65 students total. The speech was about meteorology, careers in meteorology, meteorology on TV and of course, tornadoes. Answered questions from the students as well.

4. Friday, March 4 - 9am & 1pm (2 speeches) - Had two speeches at the Head Start Program, located the Region 16 office on Cleveland Street here in Amarillo. Both groups totalled around 150 kids and 15 teachers, spoke for about 25 minutes to each group about lightning, tornadoes, severe weather, weather balloons and rain gauges.

5. Monday, March 21 - 11am - Spoke to 350 employees at the McKee Refinery, located near Sunray. These were the all the contractors at the refinery and I did their annual "weather safety" speech which included computer models, how we use them, what the forecast is for this spring, what the forecast is for the rest of the year, severe weather safety and answered questions from the audience too. The entire speech lasted 50 minutes.

### **TOWN HALL – Your Voice Your Future – March 31, 2016**

ABC 7 News held a local town hall at the Polk Street United Methodist Church on the topic of our local 911 System. Community Experts were placed on a panel where the public asked questions via social media and live at the event. The Town Hall was hosted by Mark Hyman, Sinclair Broadcast Group Baltimore, and aired live on ABC 7 from 6pm to 7pm and streamed on our website from 7:00 pm to 7:30pm.
