Needs & Issues Jan 2012

Winter hit early with snows around Halloween. We did a two part special on the homeless numbers in Amarillo in November and the different organizations that try to help the homeless population, especially when the weather turns. We rode along with police and spoke with all the shelters in town.

We did a number of stories on utility bill assistance as well. The extremes here are so pronounced in weather... that it seems the heating and electrical bills do a 180 each season. We did informative stories on ways to cut your heating bill and stay comfortable, allowing viewers to save extra money as we entered the holiday season. As we do every year in the summer, we highlighted the station sponsored fan drive, and as the weather turned, we partnered up with 2-1-1 to promote their efforts to get heaters for those in need as well.

Blood drives are always a staple of our coverage. We get press releases just about every 3-4 weeks on blood drives and as always, we help them promote their cause.

The High Plains food bank continues to be one of our favorite contributors. They held their big push in November at United supermarket and we were there to help promote their efforts. We were out the very first day the Salvation Army Bell Ringers as they started their holiday push and we did about a half a dozen stories on their

Angel Tree to provide needed gifts for children in the area.

Very close to home, we've increased our coverage with the problem of unwanted or abandoned animals. We did a two part special in November on the pet population problem here and followed Amarillo City Officials to Austin for a two day fact finding mission on making our city a no kill shelter. Their results will be highlighted in February.

And as always, still working closely with local law enforcement officials in helping to get the word out on crimes, alerts and the like. We run each of the Amarillo Police Department's Crime of the week, Fugitive of the week, and Crimestoppers program for which they seek donations. We also work with all area police on an almost daily basis as needed for crimes, accidents, traffic conditions, etc.
