## FCC Report

1. KVII's Chief Meteorologist has spent many hours in area schools, educating them about the weather and our upcoming severe weather season. His speech focus on how the bad weather forms and what they need to know and do in case of tornados.
2. With the passage of the health care reform bill, our viewers had a ton of questions about what it meant for them. We spent days asking them for those questions, we then got responses from local elected officials, including a republican and democrat, and health and insurance experts. The response was great, I think this was a great public service on the part of our station.
3. The local chapter of the Red Cross held a major fundraiser in March; we dedicated air time to make people aware of the event. We also publicized various other non-profit fundraisers and will continue to increase our effort to make the public aware of these events.
4. Since the beginning of the year, the Texas Panhandle has experienced more winter weather than we have seen in the past twenty years. This led to school closings, delays and dangerous roads. KVII committed much of our morning show, those days, to reporting on the delays and road conditions. This featured live reports with officials from the Texas Department of Public Safety telling people where the most dangerous roads were and giving advice to those who had to drive in it.
