



2nd Quarter 2023 Class A Certification for WCBZ-CD

WCBZ-CD broadcast continuously, twenty-four hours per day, during the second quarter of 2023.

Locally originated programming consisted of our local weather feed on channel 22.8. The weather feed provides a continuous twenty-four hour per day weather broadcast showing current radar conditions and forecasts.

CTV Columbus Government Television was broadcast on channel 22.6. CTV provides citizens information about the Columbus City and Franklin County government and increases citizens' accessibility to City officials and staff through quality programming that includes unedited gavel to gavel coverage of government meetings, events, documentaries, talk shows and call-in programs.

While the majority of CTV programming is originated in Columbus, specific local programs are:

- Columbus City Council meetings (live air dates April 5, 17 and 24; May 1, 15 and 22; June 5, 12 and 28; each program is approximately two hours in length)
- Franklin County Commissioners weekly meetings (original air dates April 4, 11, and 25; May 2, 16, 23 and 30; June 13, 20 and 27; each program is approximately 1 hour in length).
- Columbus Metropolitan Club weekly events (original air dates April 7, 14, 21 and 28; May 5, 12, 19 and 26; June 2, 9, 16, 23 and 30. Each program is approximately one hour in length).
- Columbus Rotary Club weekly events (original air dates April 5, 19 and 26; May 3, 10 and 17; June 7 and 14. Each program is approximately 30 minutes in length)
- Traffic Watch airs live video of Columbus area roadways weekday mornings from 5:30 AM to 8:30 AM and afternoons from 3:30 PM to 5:30 PM.

None of WCBZ-CD's channels are carried on cable networks.

WCBZ-CD has met the requirement of at least three hours per week of locally originated programming for the second quarter of 2023.
