Programs/Issues Report 4th Quarter – 2023 (October – November - December) January 9, 2024

- *Boil Water Advisory Parksville Water District: We are revisiting the Parksville Water District boil water advisories. The last three months continue to be extremely busy for the Parksville Water District and WDFB to help get the word out about the current boil water advisories for our local listeners. We are also glad to be able to inform the listeners when the advisory has been lifted.
- *Obituary Report: WDFB feels one of our responsibilities to our listeners is to inform them of our local obituaries. We give this report many times a day actually at 7:05 AM, 8:05 AM, 12:05 PM, 4:55 PM and 6:05 PM. We give this information from fifteen funeral homes. During this three month period of time we gave over 350 deaths from our community.
- *The Family Altar Program: Each Monday thru Friday a local minister makes their way to WDFB to pray for the many needs that have been called in, e-mailed or mailed in. This program is an hour in length. We have over 20 ministers that rotate on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Bro. Jr Fields host the program on Monday and Wednesday. We believe this is one of the most listened to program on WDFB. We also record the program and play it again at 7 PM and 2 AM. Yes, people actually listen at these times.
- *The Danville Salvation Army: We were honored to have Captain Alysa Irvin here to talk about the many programs from the Salvation Army. She talked about the Salvation Army Red Kettle Campaign being the biggest fundraiser for the program and how there is a need for bell ringers. Another program of the Salvation Army is the Angel Tree Program, which has been going since 1976. This year they serviced over 574 children in need. Volunteers are needed for both the ringing of the bells and also the Angel Tree program. (Interview November 18, 2023)
- *Bible Trivia: We believe this is probably one of our most popular programs on WDFB. It comes on each Sunday at 3:05 PM and airs for two hours. Mildred Drake is the host and each Sunday she has a different Co-host Lois Pike, Carol Shannon, Tony Cox, Samantha Forbes and Al Hough help out on their appointed Sundays. They ask a Bible Trivia question and callers answer, giving their favorite song to be played. We have callers from Kentucky of course, but also Alabama, Kansas and other states. We have had this program from the beginning of sign on in 1985.

*My Money Minute: As we head into the Thanksgiving/Christmas season, My Money Minute seems more relevant to the times concerning saving money, preparing a holiday budget, entertaining with less and many other subjects like this. A quick two minute program, straight to the point and a subject that we all need now. The program airs each day around 8:15 AM and at 4:50 PM.
