

## Issues and Programs List 2024 Q1 January/February/March

Agriculture – WLIL works closely with the Tennessee Farm Bureau to broadcast programs to inform listeners about current on-goings with the local 4H, FFA, and many other programs that they or their family can get involved with.

Senior Adult Issues – WLIL features updates and programs to help Seniors with any issues they may be experiencing and help them find answers on how to solve them, in association with the Loudon County Senior Center, daily schedules are broadcast to let our community seniors know where to obtain free healthcare, or anything else that they may need.

Worker Shortage – WLIL provides opportunities for businesses to reach out to the community for job positions or events like job fairs that may be going on in the community

Literacy – WLIL makes announcements to help the listening audience find opportunities to learn to read. Information is provided by local support agencies including the local library. A number of programs have been run with the aid of the literacy council and the library.

Opioids, Drugs, and Alcohol – WLIL receives information from local government offices and about ways to get the needed help. The station worked closely with the District Attorney's office to help with rehabilitation of former drug abusers.
