We have completed our review of the response of KAKW License Partnership, L.P., licensee of the above-noted stations, to the June 10, 2014 random audit letter sent to it in accordance with the provisions of Section 73.2080(f)(4) of the Commission's Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) rules.

As a result of our review, we find no further action is required. In accordance with Section 73.3526(e)(10) for commercial stations or Section 73.3527(e)(11) for noncommercial stations, the licensee must place a copy of this letter, our audit letter, and its audit response in the public inspection files of each station. Additionally, pursuant to Section 73.3526(e)(10) of the Commission's rules for commercial stations or Section 73.3526(e)(11) for noncommercial stations, the licensee must upload copies of this letter, our audit letter, and its audit response in the stations' online public inspection files. The materials must remain in the online public files until the next grant of the renewal application, by final order, of the license for the station to which the file relates.
