#### Second Quarter

##### **Issue: Living at peace with difficult People**

**April 6, 2022** At 8:00 we aired an interview with Brian Noble, Executive Director/CEO of Peacemaker Ministries for 25 minutes. He discussed mediating and living at peace with difficult people.

##### **Issue: Marital Conflict**

**April 14, 2022** Ran an interview at 9:30 for 25 minutes with Researcher and author, Shaunti Feldhahn about conflict and arguments that stem from tension from fear and values, resentment, and rejection in a marriage.

##### **Issue: Gender Dysmorphia**

**April 19, 2022** We aired an interview with author Sam Allberry about the pain and complexities of Gender Dysmorphia and how to understand what it about. 8:30 for 25 minutes.

##### **Issue: Loneliness**

**April 29, 2022** We broadcast a lecture by author and psychologist Dr Gary Smalley at 8:30 for 25 minutes about ideas and resources to overcome loneliness.

##### **Issue: Healthy Aging**

**May 11, 2022** Carried a discussion with Dr. Kenneth Cooper, the father of aerobics, at 9:30 for 25 minutes regarding how many physical ailments that accompany old age can be avoided by maintaining a healthy lifestyle. He discussed three factors that speed up the aging process, and discussed the lasting impact of a wholesome diet along with exercise.

##### **Issue: Suicide**

**May 26, 2022** We broadcast an interview with Rita Shulte, a licensed counselor, about finding healing after a loved one has committed suicide. 8:00 for 25 minutes.

**Issue: Memorial Day**

**May 30, 2022** We ran a speech by Lieutenant Colonel (Ret) Allen B. West, a combat veteran, and former member of the US Congress. For 25 minutes at 8:00, he spoke of how we can honor those who gave their lives for our freedom.

**Issue: Fatherhood**

**June 17, 2022** We aired Dr. Ed Young discuss the importance and irreplaceable role of fathers in the home at 9:30 for 25 minutes.

**Issue: Abuse**

**June 23, 2022** Carried an interview at 8:30 for 25 minutes with Dr. David Clarke about assessing a relationship and devising a plan to leave if it is abusive.

**Issue: Parenting a New Born**

**June 27, 2022** Broadcast an interview with Dr. Marilyn Maxwell, Dr. Patricia Francis, and Dr. Paul C. Reisser about being a new parent. At 9:30, for 25 minutes, they discussed breastfeeding, croup, Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), and how to child-proof a home.

**Issue: Controlling Anger**

**June 28, 2022** We carried a discussion with Deborah Pegues. She is an international speaker and interpersonal communications strategist whose trademark teaching is on how foundational beliefs dictate behavior in every aspect of life, former vice president for MCA/Universal Studios, Inc. , and best-selling author. She identified primary causes for anger and how to address them at 8:00 for 25 minutes.
