Issues List –April 1st through June 30th

Crime Concerns:

Fighting crime, remains a priority for law enforcement agencies in the Yakima Valley and in the Tricities. Cities are trying a variety of tactics with different levels of success. Some programs that have shown success have been adopted by other local governments and police agencies. Financial constraints continue to be an issue. During this quarter, we covered several stories ranging from violent crimes, property crimes, and informing the public about the most active neighborhoods and ways to maintain a secure home. We have followed up on local murders committed this year that have not been solved. Some are under the jurisdiction of the Yakima County Sheriff's Office and Tricities. At the end of March, a man murdered two employees at a Moneytree business in Yakima. The man accused of shooting the two young women to death as they prepared to open up the business could face the death penalty. This double homicide was the beginning of a string of homicides that would follow in a matter of two weeks. So far in Yakima County there have been 10 reported homicides so far this year.

Economic Concerns:

Leaders in local government at all levels continue to keep economic development near the top of the list of their priorities. Their challenge is to convince new businesses to come to the area while at the same time dealing with government cutbacks. Those cutbacks have hindered the ability to provide essential community needs like infrastructure. KUNW's coverage focuses on the decisions that directly impact the region's economic success. In Oregon, legislatures passed the a bill that will increase the minimum wage to \$15 an hour by 2018. While in the state of Washington the battle to increase the minimum wage to \$12 continues. KUNW makes it a point to focus on how the viewer's tax dollars are being spent and if they're handled appropriately. Tax-payer money could be used for Yakima's improvements and new facilities. During this quarter the debate to build a new downtown plaza in the city of Yakima remains a hot topic. While there are many supporters of this project, those opposed fear that not enough money is being spent in the right places. People and even council members who do not support the plaza project have advocated for the improvement of certain parts of the city that could use some remodeling before building a multi-million dollar plaza. KUNW also covered the importance of student safety and how it continues to be a priority for local schools.

Public Safety:

This quarter Pasco and Yakima City Council members have supported investing in projects that will benefit and improve their community's safety. From investing in resources for the homeless to sidewalk and road improvements, city officials are hoping to better the safety of their constituents. KUNW also covered many fires and road closures due to construction. As well as keeping the public informed about City Hall public meetings.

Health Issues:

KUNW covered how the lack of testing drinking water in the city of Mabton, created distrust on behalf of community members. This after E. coli was discovered in drinking water in a local school.

The discovery of the bacteria in school property made many members of the community question the reliability of their local agencies and their ability to keep the community safe. In the Tri-Cities community members became alarmed when a case of hand-foot-and-mouth disease hit the area. KUNW spoke to local medical officials to provide resourceful information for the community about the illness. Only one case was discovered in the area.

Education:

School levies have helped many school districts bring more resources and buildings to improve the education of students. School districts including Sunnyside, Grandview and Richland will soon have new facilities that will help improve learning environments for students. KUNW also covered stories about afterschool programs and summer programs that aim to help low income students, particularly.
