Traffic Stop in Milford with Weapons Charge	News	7/31/2023	6-9am	1 min	Three men have been arrested on weapons charges following a traffic stop in Milford. Police pulled over an SUV Thursday night on Water at Mystic and after learning the driver allegedly had a suspended license, went on to learn that the other men in the SUV, reportedly had active warrants for their arrest. A search of the car allegedly turned up a loaded handgun for which none of the three were licensed. They each face multiple charges and as of last night were being held in the jail.

Boynton says work continues with the developer to try to find a way to keep the post office in its current location. He says the Town has no control over the Postal Service's decision but they are trying to help.  Milford's Police Chief Selection Committee is reportedly down to four candidates with the four set to undergo assessments this weekend so see how they react to scenarios.

The Daily News reports on Tuesday night at around 10pm workers called 911 after the woman got caught in a machine at Stanley Black and Decker.
Milford Police Arrests made in Gambling Ring	News	9/1/2023	6-9am	1.5 min	Milford Police say more arrests are coming after they broke up a town wide gambling ring disguised as backyard volleyball games. The Daily News reports Police have so far arrested two people and seized thousands of dollars in cash following a several months-long investigation that involved undercover officers as well as drone surveillance. In addition to gambling police, allege there were illegal sales of alcohol and cigarettes and a concession stand with outdoor cooking that had illegal outdoor wiring and lighting.
Hopedale Fire Dept Grant	News	9/11/2023	6-9am	1 min	The Hopedale Fire Department has received a \$184,000 award from the Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighters Grant program. Town Administrator Mitch Ruscitti says the grant will allow the town to purchase state of the art firefighting equipment and modify the Hopedale Fire Station with an exhaust capturing system and remote radios as well as increased training for the town's firefighting force.

Death at Patriots Game in Foxborough	News	9/19/2023	6-9am	1 min	State Police are assisting Foxboro Police in investigating the death of a man during the Patriots Game Sunday at Gillette Stadium. The 53-year-old man reportedly had what was described as a "medical event" during the fourth quarter of the game around 11 p.m. He was rushed to an Attleboro hospital but pronounced dead about an hour later. The Norfolk District Attorney says investigators are looking into the sequence of events that led up to the medical incident but so far no one is facing any kind of charges.
Milford Reggional Medical Center to Merge with UMass Memorial Medical Center	News	9/28/2023	6-9am	1 min	Milford Regional Medical Center and UMass Memorial Medical Center are on the road to merging. In a statement released Wednesday following approval by the boards of both hospitals, Milford Regional President and CEO Ed Kelly said they have signed a non-binding Letter of Intent to explore affiliation. Kelly says the potential of being part of a larger organization offers MRMC the "stability and resources" to expand. Kelly calls it "early in the process" and says there will be no changes in patient care at this time.
