How long has Mutual Housing California been around?

Founded in 1988.

Incorporated with Yolo Mutual Housing in Davis in 2007.

What does Mutual Housing do?

Develops and operates resident-controlled communities for modest-income families in Sacramento and Yolo counties.

More than 3,000 residents, nearly half of whom are children.

People become economically stable with permanent rental housing at rates lower than market. Rents based on what is reasonable for residents' monthly income.

Why do people need affordable housing?

In Sacramento, people need to earn \$20.62 per hour to afford a two-bedroom apartment.

A single mother earning minimum wage would have to work 2.6 full-time jobs to afford a two-bedroom apartment for herself and child.

If people spend more than 30 percent of income on housing, it leaves nothing for utilities, transportation, clothing or emergencies.

Residents are veterinary or engineering techs, school counselors, cashiers, sales clerks and receptionists. Ordinary working people.
