Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the terms of the parties' agreement, DIRECTV requests that you provide certifications that confirm compliance with each of the following:

- Video description rules set forth in 47 C.F.R. § 79.3, as amended July 1, 2018 (including the number of video description hours per quarter, if applicable).
- The Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation Act (H.R. 1084/S. 2847) (CALM Act) enforced by the FCC on December 13, 2012. See, e.g., 47 C.F.R. § 76.607 (permitting MVPDs to rely on programmer certifications of compliance).
- Twenty-First Century Communications and Video Accessibility Act of 2010 (CVAA) effective as of July 1, 2012.
