DIRECTV COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATION**

MegaTV hereby certifies that during Calendar Year 2022:

Children’s Television Act of 1990 (47 C.F.R. § 76.225)

The children’s programs aired on MegaTV complied with applicable commercial limitations in children’s television programs. Specifically, programs aired that were designed for children 12 years of age and younger did not contain commercial matter exceeding 10.5 minutes per hour on weekends and 12 minutes per hour on weekdays.

Closed Captioning Requirements (47 C.F.R. § 79.1)

MegaTV is currently exempt from the requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 79.1 by virtue of that certain *Further Supplement and Amendment to Petition for Exemption of Closed Captioning Requirement* filed on July 5, 2012 for WSBS Licensing, Inc., KTBU Licensing, Inc. and Mega Media Holdings, Inc. (“Petition for Exemption”). The Petition for Exemption remains pending; accordingly, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 79.1(f)(11), during the pendency of an undue burden determination, the video programming subject to the request for exemption is considered exempt from the closed captioning requirements.

Video Description Requirements (47 C.F.R. § 79.3)

The audio description requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 79.3 are inapplicable to the MegaTV programming because MegaTV’s owned and operated television stations are not affiliates of a top four commercial television broadcast network nor is MegaTV a top five national nonbroadcast network.


Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation Act (CALM Act) Compliance

MegaTV programming complies with the CALM Act.
