Response to April 24, 2023 EEO Audit Letter

Dear Ms. Goldin:

To satisfy your EEO audit letter dated April 24, 2023, Family Broadcasting Corporation (“WHPD”) hereby uploads this response to the Online Public Inspection File (“OPIF”) for station WHPD, Dowagiac, MI, Fac. Id. 69804. The responses in this letter follow the outline in the audit letter request which begins with the number 2.

2. WHPD is the only station in its station employment unit (“SEU”). WHPD employs fewer than five full-time employees at the station. Therefore, WHPD is not required to have an EEO recruitment program and will only be responding to Questions 2 and 2(b)(vi) as directed. Further, WHPD is not subject to a time brokerage agreement; therefore, WHPD is not required to respond to Questions 3 or 4. In response to the audit question regarding full-time position job titles and number of hours regularly assigned, there are currently no full-time positions for WHPD. Station matters are handled by employees on a part-time basis.

2(b)(vi). There have been no complaints filed during WHPD’s current license term before any body having competent jurisdiction under federal, state, territorial or local law, alleging unlawful discrimination in the employment practices of the SEU on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, or sex.
