The second is of officers in Buffalo, NY pushing an elderly man to the ground fracturing his skull, and the third is a story about a police tactic that is used to prevent the public from filming them as they interact with people. The second part of today's program deals with housing discrimination and the numerous challenges Black and Brown people face when seeking shelter.
