## Children's Programming July – September 2010

**Gospel Bill** – Sheriff Gospel Bill, his deputy Nicodemus, and other western characters make up the town of Dry Gulch. Children learn about the difference between good and evil in this light drama set in the Old West. Also, Nicodemus sings in music videos that teach on the subject covered in the story. Ages 6 – 12

**K.I.C.K.S. Club** - Ralph the puppet encourages children to share and study The Word of God. Ralph also lets the children know that, “You’re a winner in Christ!”

**The Legend of Gaither's Pond** - The adventures of Big Bass and his “ fish head friends “ teach children how to make the right decisions in life. Singing, dancing, and Christian comedy make the program exciting and entertaining.
