Ascertainment Statement

News/Talk WSB develops on-air programming to address issues of significant concern to Atlanta and its surrounding communities.

Our news/talk format allows the radio station to address issues of concern in our city of license on a daily basis. Issues oriented programming aired daily includes the Neal Boortz Show, the Clark Howard Show, and the Erick Erickson Show.

News/Talk WSB airs 3.5 hours of news and information Monday through Friday morning. In addition, WSB-AM & WSBB-FM airs eleven minutes of news per hour from 9am until 12 midnight Monday through Saturday. WSB-AM & WSBB-FM carries 5 minutes of news per hour in the remaining hours.

On a quarterly basis, News/Talk WSB produces long-form special assignment reports on issues of community concern. Recent topics have included gangs, same-sex marriage, and eating disorders.

News/Talk WSB broadcasts four community affairs programs. "Perspectives" addresses multicultural issues. "Business in the Black" addresses minority issues. "21st Century Parenting Solutions" discusses parenting issues. "The Heart of Atlanta" addresses issues of interest in the city of Atlanta. "Health Talk Atlanta" addresses health issues.

Issues on these programs are ascertained through interviews with community leaders, representatives of charitable and civic organizations, and those individuals making a difference in our listening area. News/Talk WSB also solicits community input during its public affairs programming and via the radio station's website.

Producers for news/talk programs and for the community/public affairs programs are required to provide, in writing, details about each program topic, guests, and how listeners may obtain additional information about the issue.

The WSB-AM & WSBB-FM programming specialist compiles all data for the station's quarterly reports under the supervision of the assistant program director for WSB-AM & WSBB-FM who is responsible for the ascertainment process.

THE ERICK ERICKSON SHOW: Top U.S. officials moved swiftly Thursday to try to prevent diplomatic damage and contain public disgust from the release of a video that appeared to show Marines urinating on three Afghan corpses — images that spread quickly around the globe. Prior to the call, Karzai described the video as “completely inhumane and condemnable in the strongest possible terms.” His administration called on the U.S. military to “apply the most severe punishment to anyone found guilty in this crime.” The video, which runs for less than a minute, depicts four Marines in combat gear laughing and joking as they urinate on three male bodies. The caption refers to the corpses as “dead Taliban’s,” but it is unclear whether the men were civilians or fighters killed after a battle.

Taxpayers pay hundreds of thousands of dollars a year for the Fulton County government’s lobbying arm, which is pushing an agenda at the state Capitol that includes positions that run counter to the views of many residents. The commission has ordered its legislative team to fight any measures that would reshape or minimize the county government or lead to the breakaway of a new Milton County. Many North Atlanta and north Fulton residents want such changes. Fulton also will lobby against Senate Majority Leader Chip Rogers’ efforts to restrict the Tax Commissioner’s sale of tax liens to private collection companies, a system which taxpayer advocates say can leave low-income property owners buried in fines and penalties that can cost them their homes. At issue, opponents and watchdog groups say, is whether elected officials should spend countywide taxes lobbying to maintain the status quo, when so many constituents favor change. During the past six years, residents voted to form three new cities in north Fulton and one in south Fulton out of malcontent with the county government. Part of the issue stems from the county’s diverse makeup: Stretching more than 70 miles from north to south, it has nearly 1 million people. More than 90 percent now live within 14 cities, including 420,000 in Atlanta and nearly 350,000 people in north Fulton’s six cities. The county government collected more than \$420 million in property taxes last year, and many items on the lobbying list are geared to keeping revenue flowing. But some are not favored by people in certain areas. What ties everything together? Roads! What happens with the Fulton lobbyists start battling the Cobb lobbyists? This is why we have screwed up infrastructure in GA.- This is what happens when lobbyists write the legislation.

THE ERICK ERICKSON SHOW: The Georgia Supreme Court on Monday unanimously struck down a key provision of a state law that criminalized some assisted suicides, finding it violates free speech rights. The court's ruling means that four members of the Final Exit Network do not have to stand trial on felony charges in Forsyth County in connection with the 2008 suicide of 58-year-old John Celmer, who killed himself two years after he had been diagnosed with cancer. The state Legislature passed the law in 1994 to punish people like the late Jack Kevorkian, the Michigan pathologist known as "Dr. Death." He catapaulted to fame in the early 1990s by overseeing the suicides of more than 100 people, prompting a number of states to criminalize assisted suicide. The state Supreme Court said Georgia's law is unconstitutional because it does not prohibit all assisted suicides and, instead, criminalizes only those in which someone advertises or offers to assist in a suicide and then takes steps to help carry it out. "The State has failed to provide any explanation or evidence as to why a public advertisement or offer to assist in an otherwise legal activity is sufficiently problematic to justify an intrusion on protected speech rights," Justice Hugh Thompson wrote for the court. "Had the state truly been interested in the preservation of human life... it could have imposed a ban on all assisted suicides with no restriction on protected speech whatsoever," Thompson wrote. "Alternatively, the state could have sought to prohibit all offers to assist in suicide when accompanied by an overt act to accomplish that goal. The state here did neither. "Ted Goodwin, Final Exit's former president and a defendant in the Forsyth case, called the ruling "a bittersweet victory."

THE CLARK HOWARD SHOW: Every state taxes its citizens differently. Most have both a sales tax and an income tax. Some have one or the other. However, in Clark's opinion, the smartest states are ones that have no income tax at all. Texas is among nine states that collect no income tax, helping to fuel great job growth in recent years where other states have floundered. Not all states that have no income tax are doing as economically well as Texas, but this is usually due to prevailing real estate and housing market troubles. Once they surmount those issues, Clark believes these nine states will enjoy a much more robust rebound than the other states. Taxing people on what they spend, not what they make is beneficial in two ways. First, it provides folks incentive to save. Second, it encourages entrepreneurs to set up shop in that state. So why are the other states lagging behind in this idea? Because removing income taxes reduces the working capital of the state government, ultimately forcing the size of state government to shrink. It's hard to determine how to reduce services once the government has gotten used to a certain level of spending. Clark believes that if a state wants to eliminate income taxes, the way to do it is through a phased approach. If a state has a 6% income tax, reduce that rate by 1% a year over 6 years, (or 1/2% over 12 years.) This will allow the system time to adjust to a smaller tax base -- and prepare for what should prove to be much better economic growth going forward.
