Because at the time, dance music was in with the kids, so we tried to make them commercial by picking up the speed. That's what made the songs commercial."

ELENORE - The Turtles. It was meant as an anti-love letter to White Whale (their record company), who were constantly on our backs to bring them another 'Happy Together.' So I gave them a very skewed version. Not only with the chords changed, but with all these bizarre words. It was my feeling that they would listen to how strange and stupid the song was and leave us alone. But they didn't get the joke. They thought it sounded good. Truthfully, though, the production on 'Elenore' WAS so damn good. Lyrically or not, the sound of the thing was so positive that it worked. It certainly surprised me.

SESAME STREET - Exit. Little Chrissy and the Alphabets. As Little Chrissy explains what the sign is used for, his audience (including Grover, Cookie Monster, Herry Monster, Bert, Guy Smiley, and Gladys the Cow) and even the Alphabets end up abandoning the performance, exiting through the appropriately-placed door at the back of the room. By the song's end, Little Chrissy decides to leave with everyone else, but ironically forgets the way out, leaving him stranded as he cries for help.

Ma Nishtana (Hebrew: מה נשתנה), are the first two words in a phrase meaning "Why is tonight different from all other nights?" The phrase appears at the beginning of each line of The Four Questions, traditionally asked via song by the youngest capable child attending Passover Seder.

Passover, also called Pesach (/ˈpɛsəːx, ˈpeɪ-/;^[a] Biblical Hebrew: חג הפסח *Hag hapPesah*), is a major Jewish holiday that celebrates the exodus of the Israelites from slavery in Egypt,^[a] which occurs on the 15th day of the Hebrew month of Nisan, the first month of Aviv, or spring. The word Pesach or Passover can also refer to the Korban Pesach, the paschal lamb that was offered when the Temple in Jerusalem stood; to the Passover Seder, the ritual meal on Passover night; or to the Feast of Unleavened Bread.^[a]

Produced by ex-Yardbirds bassist Paul Samwell-Smith, the gospel song features a piano arrangement composed and performed by Rick Wakeman, a classically trained keyboardist well known from as a member of English prog-rockers Yes.

The single peaked at #6 on the Billboard Hot 100 and topped Billboard's Adult Contemporary chart for a week in May of 1972. In 2000, Wakeman in an interview on BBC Radio 5 Live said he had agreed to perform on the Cat Stevens track for £10 and was "shattered" that he was omitted from the credits, adding he never received the money either.

On his return to performance as Yusuf Islam, Stevens made a payment to Wakeman and apologized for the original non-payment, which arose from confusion and a misunderstanding on the record label's part. On a documentary aired on British
