Guests include; Sen. Jeff Merkley (D-OR), Rep. Will Hurd (R-TX), Sen. Amy Klobuchar (D-MN), Shawna Thomas, Jonah Goldberg, Kimberly Atkins and Peter Alexander.

Democratic presidential candidate and Vermont Independent Sen. Bernie Sanders joined Chuck Todd to talk about his presidential campaign and the divide emerging in the Democratic Party. Sen. Ron Johnson, R-Wis., weighed in on the migrant crisis and President Trump's criticism of former House Speaker Paul Ryan. Megan Rapinoe, co-captain of the world champion U.S. Women's National Soccer Team, discussed pay equity in U.S. Soccer and her exchanges with President Trump.

House Intelligence Committee Chairman Rep. Adam Schiff (D-Calif.) joined Chuck Todd to talk about former Special Counsel Robert Mueller and Democrat's divide on impeachment. Senator Rick Scott (R-Fla.) discussed the new Senate Intelligence Report on Russian election interference and reacted to President Trump's twitter attack on Representative Cummings. Billionaire Presidential Candidate Tom Steyer made his case for the impeachment of President Trump.
