He then stopped at the scene when someone from the home where the toddler lived shooting Brown and fatally wounding a 15 year old who was trying to help. Brown was a father of four with a young daughter of his own. Prophet Brown has dedicated himself to spreading the word about how we can be involved in our children's lives and make a difference in our future generations when it comes to violence, respecting the law, finishing school and become productive adults.
