A Stearns County Grand Jury Indicted Deantae Davis, Angela Jones, Kenneth Carter and Alicia Lewis on multiple counts for their role in the death of Keisha Lange. Wednesday's COVID-19 update from the Minnesota Department of Health includes 231 new cases and zero new deaths. The state's death toll now stands at 7,615 since the start of the pandemic. Of the total deaths, 59% (4485) were residents of long term care. Through July 5<sup>th</sup> the number of people with covid-19 hospitalized in Minnesota was 98. Wednesday's covid-19 update from the Minnesota Department of Health included 936 new cases and 5 newly reported deaths. The state's death toll is 7,683 since the start of the pandemic. Of the total deaths, 58.7 percent (4,515) were residents of long term care. Through August 3<sup>rd</sup> the number of people hospitalized in Minnesota was 268 up from 248 reported yesterday.
