#### Section II – Responsive Programs

The station has broadcasted programming dealing with these issues listed. Unless otherwise noted, the programming was broadcast on BOTH radio stations. This list of programs does not necessarily include all broadcasts that may have addressed the issues noted.

#### 1. Economy

"Chamber Chat" 12p Saturdays (IN JULY) – A recorded replay of Wednesdays Chamber Chat hosted on WIKB, where members of the Iron County Chamber and Chamber Alliance discuss the local economy, business, jobs, events and more.

**PSA**, :60, Aired May-July 6a-8p "Stay Postiive": PSA featuring GM Bob Black thanking advertising partners and sponsors, encouraging businesses to advertise, and offering hopeful and encouraging words about community during the Pandemic.

**PSA**, :60, Aired July 1-30 6a-8p "2020 Census": A PSA from local Census officials asking listeners to register for the census as well as providing some details and figures on the process.

**PSA**, :60, Aired July – August 4a-9a "IC Chamber Alliance": PSA providing information and direction for listeners looking for local economic or business information, event information, or contact info for local officials.

## 2. Health and Education

**PSA**, :60, Aired August – 4a-9p "IC Museum": PSA outlining aspects of the local historical museum in Iron River – exhibits, tours, information and schedules.

**NEWS**, 9/22-9/25 9-12p "Aspirus Restrictions": News release ran to alert the comunity of visitor restrictions at the local hospital due to COVID-19 outbreaks in the area.

**NEWS**, **9/23** – **9/24 9-12p** "High School COVID": News release ran to alert the community that teachers and students at a local school tested positive for COVID, and that classes would be cancelled while information is gathered by Health Department.

## 3. Community

**PSA,** :30, Aired 8/1-8/21 6a-8p — "Alvin Fire Department Brat Fry": A PSA announcing the drive-thru Brat Fry and Car Wash hosted by the Alvin Fire Department with proceeds going to the Fire Department for new radios.

**EVENT + PSA, :30, Aired 8/3-8/8 6a-8p – "WIC Fire Department Boot Drive":** A PSA for the WIC Fire Departments "Fill the Boot" fundraiser. Listeners were asked to stop by one of the local businesses (including WIKB) and drop a donation in a boot held by members of the local Fire Department. Members of the Fire Department were also interviewed for IRCB Local News.

**EVENT + PSA, :30, Aired 8/1-8/25 6a-8p – "Peddling for Preslie":** Locals held a 320 mile bike ride across the UP to raise funds for a local child diagnosed with cancer. WIKB ran a PSA throughout August leading up to the event, and TT Host Adam Stender was on site and participated in the beginning of the ride. This fundraiser was also discussed and promoted with Call-Ins on Telephone Time.

**PSA,** :30 Campaign, Aired 9/1-9/30 6a-8p — "Suicide Prevention Month": A flight of PSAs aimed at providing education, support and resources for dealing with mental illness and suicide with a focus on teen suicide. Spots provided tips, tools and resources for those dealing with or who know someone dealing with potential mental illness.

**NEWS**, 9/8-9/12 9a-12p "Fall Artisan Market": Michigamme Township held an outdoor market on September 13<sup>th</sup> that included Artists, Artisans and Crafters selling and displaying their works, as well as food, music and games. WFER promoted this in the week leading up to the event through Local News Coverage.
