The stories during first quarter centered around the search for the missing couple as well as the plans to restructure Crooked Creek. The newscast on February 5 th confirmed that remains found were those of John Villines. Wife Amy's remains were discovered a short distance from her husbands on February 5 th . The Harrison community mourned the loss of the couple and several of our stories featured audio clips from Harrison Mayor Jerry Jackson. March 24ths story centered around the restructuring of Crooked Creek due to aging low water dam and the negative ecological impact that Lake Harrison has on the environment.
