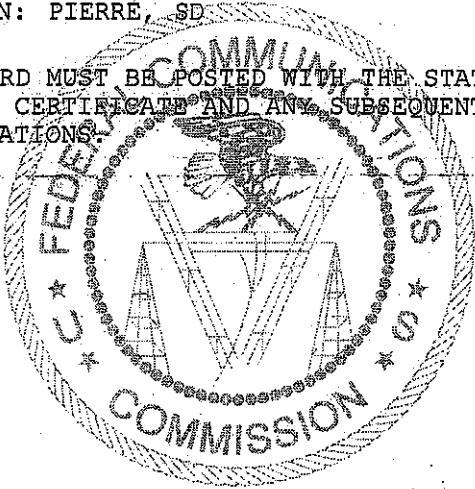

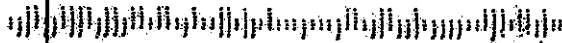

The Commission reserves the right during said license period of terminating this license or making effective any change, or modification of this license which may be necessary to comply with any decision of the Commission rendered as a result of any hearing held under the rules of the Commission prior to the commencement of this license period or any decision rendered as a result of any such hearing which has been designated but not held, prior to the commencement of this license period.

The license is issued on the licensee's representation that the statements contained in the licensee's application are true and that the undertakings therein contained so far as they are consistent herewith, will be carried out in good faith. The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve the public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 808 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Pursuant to Section 316(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, Class IV AM Station KCCR, PIERRE, SD SHALL SHOW CAUSE why its license SHOULD NOT BE MODIFIED to specify operation with a nighttime power of 1 kilowatt instead of the current nighttime power of 250 watts.

Pursuant to SECTION 1.87 of the Commission's Rules, the licensee of Station KCCR may, not later than June 1, 1984, request that a hearing be held on the proposed modification or file a written statement in opposition to the modification proposed in this Order to Show Cause. In such case, the Commission will conclude that Station KCCR does not wish to increase its nighttime power, and the license for Station KCCR will not be modified. Instead, the station will retain its current nighttime power of 250 watts.

In the event the Commission receives no written opposition to the proposed modification, the right to a hearing will be considered to have been waived, and the licensee of Station KCCR will be deemed to have consented to the modification. Although the license will be so modified, this modification WILL NOT BECOME EFFECTIVE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE and nighttime operation with 1 kilowatt nighttime should NOT commence until that date to be announced.

This letter should be posted as part of the station's license.
