When a family is referred to Child Protective Services, they're often treated a lot like criminals on parole and the administrative work required to keep families together can actually make it more difficult to parent successfully. Sociology professor Christa Moore said that our child welfare system should operate more like collaborative care and less like bureaucratic punishment. Plus: How does having a parent who is incarcerated affect young people as they get older? Heidi Williams talked with 18 - 25 year olds whose parents were incarcerated at some point during their childhood. She found that many of them were extra-motivated to succeed and, particularly, to help younger siblings.
