- **Employment:** Kimberly Dir. Of Workforce Development, of the Chicago Urban League weekly segment informs listeners about employment opportunities.
- **News:** WVON celebrated Black Music Month with the featured soundtracks from movies that shaped the African-American life soundtrack all month from favorite black films.
