# WVON Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WVON provides its listeners with programming and public announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- employment: Karen Coleman Dir. Of Workforce Development, of the Chicago Urban League weekly segment informs listoners about employment opportunities.
- News: Perri Small show spoke with three-time WNBA MVP and a four-time Olympic gold medal winner, Lisa Leslie and discussed nutritional advice for parents trying to make sure their kids eat well in today's busy world.
