#### WVON Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WVON provides its listeners with programming and public announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- employment: Karen Coleman Dir. Of Workforce Development, of the Chicago Urban League weekly segment informs listeners about employment opportunities.
- News: WVON spoke with Kevin Frazier, a co-host of
   Entertainment Tonight and the founder and Owner of the
   urban entertainment website HipHollywood.com. The
   discussion centered around Russell Simmons, the hip-hop
   mogul who co-founded Def Jam Records and a slew of other
   businesses, stepping down from his companies after a woman
   said he sexually assaulted her in 1991.
- Professor Kelly Lytle Bernandez, Interim Director of UCLA's Ralph J. Bunche Center for African American Studies, joined Perri Small. The discussion centered around a new report from researchers at the University of California at Los Angeles, a staggering \$19 billion has been levied against people arrested by the LAPD. The data, which was analyzed by the Million Dollar Hoods Research team at UCLA, shows that city residents pay a steep price before their innocence or quilt has been determined.
- Perri Small was joined by Adotei Akwei, the Managing Director for Government Relations for Ammesty International to discuss footage released by CNN that showed men being sold at an auction in Libya.
- WVON spoke to Dan Mihalopoulos, staff reporter with Chicago Sun-Times about Forrest Claypool resignmation as chief executive officer of the Chicago Public Schools three days after CPS' top internal investigator called for fixing the longtime go-to guy for Mayor Rahm Emanuel for engaging in a "full-blown cover-up" of a top aide's cthical violation.

News/community: Cliff Kelley talked with Attorney G. Flint Taylor about the 48th Anniversary of Fred Hampton's Murder.

WVON spoke to Attorney William Pintas and discussed representing seriously injured victims nationwide and his specialties include lung cancer, dangerous daugs, nursing home injuries, slips and falls and much more.

Perri Small spoke to Dr. Carla Harwell, MD, a member of the Movement is Life Executive Steering Committee and discussed a study that finds African Americans and Hispanics are more likely to receive inequitable healthcare compared to whites. Based on recent changes in payment models, higher risk patients are less likely to receive specialty care due to concerns related to the increased costs of managing this patient group.

WVON spoke to Ruth Glenn, executive director for the National Coalition Against Domestic Violence, to discuss the GOP's layest Gun Bill that would effectively "zero out" countless state laws designed to protect victims of abuse.

Listeners talked to Dwight James, Executive Director of the South Carolina State Conference NAACP, about the 20-year prison sentence former North Charleston police officer Michael Slager received today for the shooting death of Walter Scott.

WVON spoke to Aysha Butler, President of the Resident Association of Greater Englewood, about the drop in shootings and homicides in Englewood and the programs that are keeping residents engaged.


