## **Detroiters Keep on Painting to Lift Neighborhood**

**DETROIT, MI** – Fitzgerald Park residents will continue working Saturday and through the summer to help craft artwork and map an artistic vision for their neighborhood as part of the area’s revitalization efforts.

Charles “Chazz” Miller is leading the Detroit Neighborhood Arts Project, a community-driven effort to transform public spaces through murals and other artwork. In the Fitzgerald Park area, residents will focus their vision for larger murals as part of the Papillon Effect Project, which includes creating a collection of colorfully painted plywood butterflies and placing those throughout the neighborhood. Residents will paint and plan at the following sessions:

**Saturday, May 11, noon-5 p.m. across the street from HomeBase, 7426 W. McNichols**

**Saturday, May 18, 1-3 p.m., across the street from HomeBase, 7426 W. McNichols**

“Too often, development happens without the community’s input, and that’s what makes this project so unique,” said Miller. “They’re not just coming up with the vision; they’re actually helping to put it in place.”

Located on Puritan between Wyoming and Livernois in Detroit, the murals and other art will be installed between now and July 26. The effort is funded through a grant from the Mural Arts Institute of Mural Arts Philadelphia.

“I think bringing artists in to work with community members directly and engaging folks in a participatory process is urgent and essential,” explained Mural Arts Institute Director Netanel Portier. “We’re thrilled to work with Chazz and the Live6 Alliance to make that happen.”

The mural project is part of a larger revitalization effort that includes rehabbing more than 100 homes and converting more than 200 vacant lots to greenspace, and follows the May 2 opening of the HomeBase community center. Another group, Live6 Alliance, is helping to lead the efforts.

Miller is an internationally-recognized artist and the founder of Public Art Workz!, which was created to promote art education and community beautification.
