Gasoline prices are finally levelling off and even decreasing in Southeast Texas, just in time for the July 4 holiday.

A new \$3.6 million grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) will help build a new elementary school in the southern Orange County town of Bridge City. The school, Sims Elementary, was severely damaged by floodwaters during Hurricane Ike.

The Obama administration is awarding the Port Arthur Police Department more than \$1 million and the Beaumont ISD Police Department more than \$150,000 in grants to keep police officers on the beat during the economic downturn. The City of Newton will receive more than \$146,000.

The average price for a gallon of unleaded gasoline has increased about 11 cents in Beaumont during the past week, according to a survey released Thursday by AAA Texas.

### **NEWS AT NOON** 09/08/09 (3:00)

The state's transportation agency says it expects to receive the needed funding to widen one of Port Arthur's most heavily traveled highways. The Texas Department of Transportation says it plans to widen the portion of FM 365 between US 69 and West Port Arthur Road (Spur 93) using federal stimulus money, or ARRA funding.

A Dallas Morning News analysis of federal grants and contracts, in Monday's editions, shows Texas has been approved for about \$12.9 billion in stimulus grants and contracts. That doesn't include the estimated \$4.2 billion that Texans received through the law's main individual tax credit, according to federal estimates.
