

- 1. Crime/Safety including crime prevention and notable local cases, alcohol and drug abuse, fire safety and police conduct.
 - Keeping You Safe: Recurring segments which address issues of personal and community safety.
 - Military/Terrorism: Part of Safety, includes reports on suspected terror threats, airport, and Homeland security, as well as initiatives to support servicemen and women.
- 2. Education including education standards, school safety, and alternative schools.
- 3. Racism/Discrimination including affirmative action, NAACP activities, LGBTQ Rights, ADA, race relations and diversity initiatives.
- 4. Family Issues/Welfare including suitable housing, welfare to work issues, parenting, and fatherhood initiatives, building stronger families and family values.
- 5. The Economy including business development, community infrastructure, small business development, and visitor attractions. Also includes personal economic issues such as Credit Cards, Income, Taxes and Investing.
- 6. Recreation including activities for youth and adults, and the arts.
- 7. Community Involvement/Development including volunteerism, blood drives, revitalizing neighborhoods, mentoring, and fundraising activities.
 - Politics 2023: part of Community Involvement, including discussions of national and local issues and candidates, as well as voter registration and participation issues.
- 8. Employment including job opportunities, downsizing, training, and outplacement.
- 9. Environment/Animals including chemical spills, landfills, water quality and smog, and animal protection and conservation.
- 10. Healthy Living including exercise, dieting, disease prevention, and personal safety issues, as well as mental health initiatives and new treatment options.

- Alzheimer's Association: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :15 and :30 second public service announcement for this campaign. Messaging includes awareness and fundraising for research along with symptoms to look for in loved ones potentially suffering from the disease.
- But, Stuff: During the quarter, WXIX aired a:30 second public service message for this organization. Message alerting viewers to the dangers of Colon Cancer and encourage the audience to get a colonoscopy.
- Big brothers Big sisters: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :15 and :30 second public service announcement for this organization. Their campaign includes Cincinnati Bengals players encouraging the public to volunteer and become mentors for children across the Tri-State.
- Chron's Colitis Foundation of America: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :30 second public service message for this organization. Campaign focused on educating viewers on the signs of the disease and symptoms to look for in children.
- Cleveland Clinic Cancer PSA: During the quarter, WXIX aired a:30 second public service message for this organization. Cleveland Clinic is partnering with Velasano to raise awareness about a year-long fundraiser focusing on cancer research.
- Concussion Awareness Now: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :30 second public service message for this organization. The PSA encourages viewers to check for a concussion from everyday injuries and informs viewers about the warning signs of this serious injury.
- Design with a Heart: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :30 second public service message for this organization. Philanthropic venture with "Furniture Fair", helping families furnish their home after summering from homelessness in the tri-state area.
- FEMA Be a Hero: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :30 & :60 second public service message for this organization. The PSA featuring cartoon superheroes stressing the importance to create a family disaster plan.
- Fentanyl REAL: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :30 second and :60 second public service message for this organization. Message geared toward children about the dangers of Fentanyl and discouraging myths about the dangerous drug.
- Junior Achievement: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :15 & :30 second public service message for this organization. The PSA focuses on the benefits of teaching youth the importance of managing finances at an early age and how the organization, Junior Achievement, provides such resources.

PSA's included: calling before you dig to locate underground utilities, the importance of higher education and the impact of Opioid Addiction education and treatment.
