- 5. The Economy including business development, community infrastructure, small business development, and visitor attractions. Also includes personal economic issues such as Credit Cards, Income, Taxes and Investing.
- 6. Recreation including activities for youth and adults, and the arts.
- 7. Community Involvement/Development including volunteerism, blood drives, revitalizing neighborhoods, mentoring, and fundraising activities.
 - Politics 2023: part of Community Involvement, including discussions of national and local issues and candidates, as well as voter registration and participation issues.
- 8. Employment including job opportunities, downsizing, training, and outplacement.
- 9. Environment/Animals including chemical spills, landfills, water quality and smog, and animal protection and conservation.

- 10. Healthy Living including exercise, dieting, disease prevention, and personal safety issues, as well as mental health initiatives and new treatment options.
 - Corona Virus: Part of Health, includes updates on issues relating to the Covid-19 outbreak, such as health information, public orders, and other relevant information.

SITTING FOR JUSTICE (60 Minutes, February 26, 2023)

Gray-produced original Black History Month special entitled Sitting for Justice.

The special will cover the events leading up to the historic Montgomery Bus Boycott with perspective from Fred Gray, who served as legal representation for Rosa Parks, Martin Luther King Jr. and others during the Civil Rights movement. Also features the story of Claudette Colvin who was arrested nine months prior to Rosa Parks for refusing

to give up her seat on a Montgomery Bus. Claudette's story has recently made national news, and her arrest record was expunged December 16, 2021. Sitting for Justice tells personal accounts from key individuals who helped start a movement that changed Montgomery....and eventually the nation.

EVERYDAY HEROES: VALIANT HEROES (30 Minutes, March 12, 2023)

Gray-produced original Everyday Heroes: Valiant Heroes. March is an important month to honor our most valiant heroes. From Medal of Honor recipients like Leroy Petrey who lost his arm in combat but saved the lives of his fellow soldiers, to those brave few who became the first "Women Airforce Service Pilots", Everyday Heroes will showcase the courage, determination, and fearlessness of these brave individuals. March is women's history month and special attention will be paid to honor the legacy left by so many that has helped to shape our country. On March 25th we also celebrate National Medal of Honor day which allows us to reflect on the most heroic of us all.

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS (any day, any time)

- Autism: During the quarter, WXIX aired several: 15 and: 30 second and 1:00 minute public service announcements for several organizations supporting this issue. The PSA's reminds parents that early screening for autism can make a world of difference in their child's development and their enjoyment of everyday things others take for granted. Also addressed children directly that it is OK to be who they are.
- Barron Prize: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :30 second and :60 second public service message. Organization is focused on encouraging students in high school present their best ideas that could change the world and inspire others. PSA campaign is designed to encourage entries.
- Big Brothers Big Sisters: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :30 second and :15 second public service message for this organization. Campaign designed to encourage viewers to adopt a "little" and become a "big" or mentor in a child's life. Cincinnati Bengals players are featured to support the organization.
- But, Stuff: During the quarter, WXIX aired a:30 second public service message for this organization. Message alerting viewers to the dangers of Colon Cancer and encourage the audience to get a colonoscopy.
- Chron's Colitis Foundation of America: During the quarter, WXIX aired a :30 second public service message for this organization. Campaign focused on educating viewers on the signs of the disease and symptoms to look for in children.

- Keep America Beautiful: During the quarter, WXIX aired: 30 second and: 60 second public service messages for this organization. Campaign focuses on encouraging people to recycle in their community.
