The following report reflects on the formal coverage of these community issues. WXCZ & WXZC FM informally addresses many other issues in the Citrus County market through aggressive public service announcement rotation and local news coverage.

TIMES: Throughout the period according to dates and times of various seminars, public meetings and other contacts by local, state and federal agencies.

DURATION: 15, 30 & 60 Second Live and pre-recorded Public Service Announcements on a continuing basis.

1) Issue: PUBLIC SAFETY

DESCRIPTION: WXCZ FM air information concerning PUBLIC SAFETY issues during our public service broadcasts that effect the Nature Coast area.

2) Issue: DISASTER PREPAREDNESS IN THE NATURE COAST

DESCRIPTION: In the past the Nature Coast has always been aware of natural disasters. Hurricanes and severe thunderstorms with lightning have always been of concern for our community. Being surrounded by water and flooding is a concern as well. Local agencies along with the Federal Emergency Management Agency, the local Emergency Preparedness Agency and all the law enforcement agencies regularly schedule seminars for the public on how to plan for these situations. WXCZ & WXZC is part of the local network of radio stations that have a direct link to these agencies so information can be given out to the public. In addition, during recent potential severe weather our air staff provided constant updates to our listeners regarding expected conditions and tips from the NOAA and the National Hurricane Center. ^This year, the station participated in a water and supply drive that resulted in two truckloads of support being delivered to the Panhandle.

3) Issue: BENEFITS AND FUNDRAISERS

DESCRIPTION: WXCW & WXZC FM is proud of their continued involvement with local charities that conduct fund raising events on the Nature Coast. A large portion of WXCW & WXZC Public Service Announcements are devoted to fund raising organizations and events providing listeners with information on how to get involved. When possible our on air personalities participate in these local fund raising events by drawing our audience to participate.

Issue: SUPPORT OF AREA VETERANS


Our station is heavily involved with numerous organizations that serve the area's veteran population. As a result many returning area veterans require assistance in making a successful transition to civilian life.

We still do everything we can do participate in any way possible.
