Each business puts a sign in their window which tells kids that they can stop inside as a safe place to get help. A team member from the "Y's" Safe Place program will then meet with that child to find a safe way forward. The goal is to prevent human trafficking, physical abuse, and substance abuse and to promote mental health in teenagers.
