**Re: Notice of New DMA
Mandatory Carriage Election
WUGA-TV, Toccoa, Georgia**

Dear Mr. Stewart:

Pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, the University of Georgia hereby notifies you of its formal request for mandatory carriage of the digital signal of Noncommercial Educational Television Station WUGA-TV, Toccoa, Georgia, on any and all cable systems owned and/or operated by your company in the station's "television market" (as defined by FCC rules), including without limitation those served by the headends listed in Attachment A. WUGA-TV does not substantially duplicate the primary channel programming of any other television station in either DMA.

In the 2009-10 Nielsen Station Index, Nielsen Media Research assigned WUGA-TV to the Greenville-Spartanburg-Asheville-Anderson DMA. In July 2011, however, Nielsen re-assigned WUGA-TV to the Atlanta DMA in light of the station's actual service area and its close nexus with the University of Georgia, which is based in nearby Athens. Please see the letter attached as Attachment B.

The licensee of WUGA-TV recognizes that it will not have the ability to enforce must-carry rights in the Atlanta DMA until the 2015-17 carriage cycle, when the applicable NSI reflects WUGA-TV's assignment to the Atlanta DMA. Nevertheless, at this time, we would like to discuss with you carriage of WUGA-TV throughout the eastern portion of the Atlanta DMA commencing as soon as possible.
