DRS. CORNER: The Drs. corner is public affairs program hosted by a local dentist who interviews a different doctor every Friday. A family practitioner, surgeon, cardiologist, and a vet to name a few. The programs runs about 30 minutes and airs at 8am.

COMMUNITY SPOTLIGHT: The Community Spotlight is a 30 minute program where people are interviewed on non-profit community events in great detail. The Community Spotlight airs every Tuesday at 8am.

TRADING POST: The Trading Post is a program that airs seven days a week at 12:30pm. People can advertise items they have for sale, lost, or found. and if they have a yard or garage sale for a small fee as long as they are not in the regular business of buying or selling the listings advertised. The length of the program varies, pending on the number of items we have. It runs no longer than 15 minutes.

JOB BANK: The Job Bank is a program that airs Monday-Friday where businesses are looking for someone to fill a vacancy or an individual is looking for employment may advertise for a small fee. It runs immediately after the trading post.

SWAP SHOP: The Swap Shop is very similar to the Trading Post except the primary focus is on agriculture items. and it airs at 6:40am.

COUNTRY CALENDAR: The Country Calendar is a list of community events like the local V.F.W. meeting, A drive-thru dinner to help defray medical expenses for someone in need, and non-profit events. Airs at various times.

4-H REPORT : The 4-H report is a 15 minute program done by the county 4-H agent. She gives news on 4-H events. It airs at 8am on Wedensdays.

COUNTY AGENT REPORT: The county agent report is program where the county agent gives news in the world of agriculture and the Home Extension Agent gives homemaking tips. It airs at 8am Thursdays.
