Air Date: July 4, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:38)

Description: Illinois gas prices rise further with new Illinois and Lake County gas taxes. Waukegan man drowns in Waukegan Harbor. Lake County Sheriff K9 Dax nabs suspect in stolen vehicle in North Barrington. Zion woman arrested in accidental shooting and killing of 16-year-old as they played with gun. Antioch Township man arrested earlier this year gets new charges. Drivers license renewal extension until January announced by SOS. Chicago man pleads guilty to 2019, 2020 and 2021 incidents in Lake County

Air Date: July 18, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:44)

Description: Illinois gas prices continue to be highest in the midwest, with no sign of slowing. Lake County man suffers major injuries in McHenry County crash. Highland Park man pleads not guilty to child porn and battery charges. Charges filed in April road rage incident in Volo where gun was displayed. Overdose death record set in US, up in Lake County as well. Legislative map lawsuits to be heard by 3-judge panel. Lake County Health Department releases info on two data breaches

Air Date: July 25, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:55)

Description: Illinois gas prices continue to be highest in the midwest, now 11th highest in the nation. Illinois Governor announced run for 2nd term. Mundelein man arrested for drunk driving 102 mph in a 45 zone, with a child in the car. Police in Antioch announce two arrests in separate gun issues. Zion man awaits sentencing after conviction in 2017 attack on apartment residents. Man involved in Gurnee area murder pleads guilty to lesser charges, will testify against other suspect. 26-billion dollar opioid settlement announced, Illinois to get 790-million-dollars.

Air Date: August 1, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:51)

Description: Illinois gas prices continue to be highest in the midwest, remain 11th highest in the nation. Illinois goes with backtracked CDC recommendations on masking

indoors. Woman killed in North Chicago shooting. 3-year-old Lake Villa child, and 35-year-old man dead in Lake County drownings. Lou Malnati's Pizza to move HQ into Lake County. A chase through Wauconda and Mundelein leads to arrest. Round Lake Beach man already in jail, gets new charges behind bars. Round Lake Beach man arrested after fight with police in Kenosha County.

Air Date: August 8, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 27:49)

Description: Illinois gas prices continue to be highest in the midwest, remain 11th highest in the nation. Masks once again required for schools, Governor also announced a vaccine mandate for state workers. Several arrests made in Lake County gang sting. Man facing several charges for hitting Libertyville Police officer after hit and run accident. Rod Blagojevich wants the ability to run for political office again. Man wanted by Wisconsin Prison authorities arrested in Lake County. Weed sales in Illinois hit new record in July thanks to Lollapalooza

Air Date: August 15, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:08)

Description: Illinois gas prices continue to be highest in the midwest, remain 11th highest in the nation. A 3rd arrest made in a May of 2020 murder in unincorporated Gurnee. Gurnee Police announce one arrest, and look for a 2nd suspect in armed robbery attempt. A double shooting in Waukegan being looked into, two people hurt in the incident. Fright Fest to return to Great America after pandemic hiatus in 2020. A former SEDOL Paraprofessional pleads guilty to abusing a student. North Chicago man arrested after threatening deputies during eviction. Joliet man drowns on Chain, while attempting to help struggling swimmer.

Air Date: August 22, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 27:33)

Description: Illinois gas prices fall, but continue to be highest in the midwest, remain 11th highest in the nation. Two bodies found in Lake Michigan, one identified. Census numbers come in, Lake County grows, but slowly, Volo the biggest percentage gain. House fire kills one in Libertyville, one person stabbed in separate Libertyville incident. Marine Corps recruiter who works at Great Lake gets child porn charges. First human case of West Nile virus found in Illinois since 2018. Former Coroner's employee pleads not guilty to illegally recording death notification.

Air Date: August 29, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 27:10)

Description: Illinois gas prices fall, but continue to be highest in the midwest, now 10th highest in the nation. Two more drownings reported in Lake County, one in Fox Lake, one in Lake Michigan. A shooting investigated in Wadsworth. A man from Plainfield man arrested for causing fatal 5 vehicle crash in Fox Lake. A Waukegan woman accused of causing wrong way crash on I-94 in Racine County, Wisconsin. Home invasion investigated in Waukegan Township, no arrests. New mask and vaccine mandates

announced by Governor. Woman arrested for stabbing vehicle passenger on I094 near Old Mill Creek.

Air Date: September 5, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 27:32)

Description: Illinois gas prices heading back up, and continue to be highest in the midwest. Woman found dead in Lake Michigan August 15th finally identified as likely Chicago murder victim. One person hurt after crashing motorcycle during police pursuit in Wauconda. Zion man arrested for shooting between two vehicles in McHenry County. Shooting in Waukegan leaves 18-year-old seriously injured. Illinois unemployment 8th worst in nation, on average 3% higher than border states. Gages Lake man accused of stabbing woman, bit by police dog. Former Waukegan school bus driver hit with sex crime charges.

Air Date: September 12, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:24)

Description: Illinois gas prices heading back up, and continue to be highest in the midwest. Zion man being sought after escaping custody once he learned he was wanted in shooting. Another man throws hat in ring for GOP Governor nod. Wauconda Police officer uses car to block wrong way drunk driver. ID's made in fatal shooting in Waukegan, and crash in Wauconda. Waukegan man arrested in Evanston murder, and double shooting Waukegan on same day. Man who fled to Poland after fatal Lake County crash, convicted after 20-plus years.

Air Date: September 19, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 27:38)

Description: Illinois gas prices heading back up, and are back 11th worst in the nation. A double murder in North Chicago being investigated. Lake County Sheriff's K9 Diesel dies from cancer. A Schaumburg man dies after falling from canoe into Fox Lake. Lockdown situations lead to arrest of high school students in Zion, Lake Zurich. Former SEDOL teacher's aide gets prison for sexual abuse of student. A man convicted of killing ex-wife in Gurnee gets denied a new trial. McHenry County man denies trying to meet underage girl in Lake County.

Air Date: September 26, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 27:31)

Description: Illinois gas prices remain high, and the highest east of the Rocky Mountains. Murder in both Zion and Waukegan being looked into. Prosecutors denied the use of some information at trial of former Antioch resident Kyle Rittenhouse. Waukegan Police arrest a pair of students for bringing a replica gun on school grounds. A Lake Bluff man already facing sex crime charges, facing new charges after sexual assault arrest. Lake Bluff man arrested for attempting to lure 12-year-old North Carolina Boy. Four Lake County Schools named national "Blue Ribbon" winners
