During this quarter, this station gave particular attention to the issues listed in the following report. These issues are not listed in order of importance and it should be noted that the station may have also aired other programming that was responsive to the community's informational Needs.

Air Date: October 3, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 27:35)

Description: A Lake Villa man hit with drug induced homicide charge in McHenry County OD. Lake County man dies of rabies, first human case in 67 years in Illinois. A possible Waukegan casino suitor drops out after Bears purchase Arlington Park. Gas prices in Illinois stay highest east of the Rocky Mountains. A man seeks a new trial in 2002 Antioch murder. Former Lake County Jail guard pleads not guilty to sexual relationship with inmate. Zion man arrested for shooting while on bond for a different shooting.

Air Date: October 10, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:17)

Description: Sheriff's K9 Dax hunts down two stolen vehicle suspects near Lake Bluff. Appellate court to look into jury selection in Beach Park murder case. Man attempts to escape from Lake County Court and Jail, fails both times. Three people arrested by Waukegan Police on weapons charges. Illinois gas prices increase, Lake County also rises. A man wanted on Wisconsin DOC and Kenosha County warrants arrested in Lake County. A former nurse in Libertyville is charged in connection to patient death at hospital.

Description: Illinois gas prices continue higher trend, and highest in Midwest standing. Two Zion residents were charged in the stabbing of their housemate. Authorities seek vehicle in fatal hit and run near Vernon Hills. A Waukegan man gets convicted of attempted murder, after woman rejects romantic advances. Round Lake man attempts to save canoe, drowns in Highland Lake. Waukegan casino finalists battle in front of the Illinois Gaming Board. Lake County Board to reduce trustees from 21 to 19 come 2022.

Air Date: October 24, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:32)

Description: Illinois gas prices climb, state now has the 9th highest in the country. Vehicle found in fatal hit and run near Vernon Hills, no arrests announced. Innocent woman shot and killed in her home in Zion. Healthcare employees in Lake County lose jobs over Covid-19 vaccine mandates. Police in Waukegan make arrest in summer murder. Lake County man gets prison time for stealing money from a charity he ran.

Protestors gather to criticize Lake County State's Attorney over lack of ruling in year old Waukegan Police Shooting.

Air Date: October 31, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 27:51)

Description: Illinois gas prices climb again, remain 9th highest in the country. North Chicago man shot and killed in park city, two 15-year-olds arrested for the shooting. Homeless man faces charges in Vernon Hills bus stabbing. Stabbing at the Zion Benton High School leaves one injured, one arrested. Kenosha man faces charges for fighting Lake County Sheriff's Deputies and Jail Guards. Beach Park murder conviction will stand after no racial bias found in jury selection. Lake County man off to the federal pen for income tax evasion. Lake County Sheriff's Office announced the 5th sworn K9 officer.

Air Date: November 7, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time 28:05)

Description: Illinois gas prices up again, still sit at 9th highest in the country. Investigation ongoing into loud sounds heard across northwest Lake County. Charges filed against two people in a mail check stealing scheme. Governor JB Pritzker declares gun violence a public health issue. Illinois State Treasurer looks to return 11 Purple Hearts, including one from Waukegan. Fox Lake bank branch worker robbed near ATM. Public Health officials say those eligible for Covid booster shot should get one.

Description: Police looking for 16-year-old in Zion murder case. Antioch Police make an arrest of a man who wanted to meet a 14-year-old. Officials make an arrest in connection with a body found floating in Lake Michigan near Waukegan over the summer. Gas prices remain high, but fall slightly from last week's numbers. More sex crime charges filed against former Waukegan bus driver. Illinois Secretary of State changes web address, makes site easier to navigate. Second man pleads guilty in Lake Villa man's murder. Lake County Board passes 2022 budget.

Air Date: December 12, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time 27:11)

Description: Waukegan casino developer finally chosen. Police looking into killings in Gurnee and North Chicago. Police involved shooting leaves man dead in Buffalo Grove. A convicted sex offender dies of "natural causes" in the Lake County Jail. Man wanted by Illinois DOC arrested in Zion, and picks up new charges. Ingleside woman and ex-husband face charges in stabbing of woman's boyfriend. A Round Lake Beach man was arrested for stabbing a woman. Antioch man arrested for pistol whipping woman. K9 Boomer tracks suspect near Grayslake, finds guns and drugs.

Air Date: December 19, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time 28:15)

Description: Arrest of Waukegan man made in Zion murder from September. Double shooting in early December now changes scope after one victim dies. Antioch woman accused of stabbing boyfriend during altercation. Lake County Board to have two less seats come 2022. Gas prices in Illinois continue to be highest in the Midwest, though Lake County prices have dropped. Update after Covid vaccines reach one year mark. Illinois unemployment falls, but remains far behind national and Wisconsin average. Grayslake State Senator Melinda Bush to step down after term.
