Air Date: June 6, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:51)

Description: Illinois continues to march forward toward a June 11th reopen date from Covid. Vaccinations wane, but Illinois to offer more incentives, including free alcohol. A Zion man convicted and sentenced on drug and weapons charges...but now he's missing. Illinois passes controversial budget under cover of darkness. A Lindenhurst man accused of stealing, and selling electronics stolen from Gurnee school district. Man arrested after abducting his own child from North Chicago. Another Michael Madigan underling facing federal charges. A man shot in Lake County four years ago, dies...the investigation is ongoing. A man faces charges for threatening a Mundelein School, then getting into a jail fight.

Description: Illinois fully reopens from Coronavirus restrictions. Illinois Governor breaks campaign promise and signs new maps, GOP sues. Police in Waukegan investigating murder seen by several witnesses who haven't come forward. Both suspects in a Beach Park double murder face new or additional charges. Sketch released after rape of 16 year old on Beach Park trail. Search warrant leads to drug/weapons charges against Round Lake man. Three Lake County jail guards credited with saving life of OD'ing inmate.

Air Date: June 20, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 27:37)

Description: Waukegan police looking into murder, no arrests so far. Gurnee man gets prison in accidental shooting death of girlfriend. Ruse burglary reports on the rise in Lake County. Arrest made in bike path sexual assault in Beach Park. Police looking into a giant brawl at Six Flags Great America. Illinois gas prices remain highest in the midwest and 8th highest in the nation. More lawsuits over newly signed legislative maps. Palatine man pleads not guilty in Lake Barrington attack.

Air Date: June 27, 2021 at 5:20 AM (Running Time: 28:26)

Description: Illinois maintains highest gas prices in the midwest, with more taxes coming in July. Waukegan police are investigating two shootings, one left a person dead, the other left one injured. Sheriff's officials investigating a shooting in Beach Park that left one injured. Illinois to move the 2022 primary as part of a new voting initiative. Two Lake County residents among 5 people facing federal charges for selling defense equipment to Russia. Illinois gets positive credit ratings outlook, GOP calls it "temporary."
