Georgia Public Telecommunications Commission (Combined Report)

This report covers the following fourteen noncommercial educational radio and eight noncommercial educational television stations licensed to Georgia Public Telecommunications Commission ("GPTC") as well as the headquarters of the GPTC in Atlanta: Stations WABR (FM), Tifton; WACG (FM), Augusta; WGPB (FM), Rome; WJSP (FM), Warm Springs; WJWV (FM), Ft. Gaines; WPPR (FM), Demorest; WNGU (FM), Dahlonega; WSVH (FM), Savannah; WUGA (FM), Athens; WUNV (FM), Albany; WUWG (FM), Carrollton; WWET (FM), WWIO (FM), Brunswick; Valdosta; WXVS (FM), Waycross; WABW-TV, Pelham; WACS-TV, Dawson; WCES-TV, Wrens; WNGH-TV, Chatsworth; WMUM (FM), Cochran; WMUM (TV), Cochran; WJSP-TV, Columbus; WVAN-TV, Savannah; and WXGA-TV, Waycross. This report also covers two noncommercial educational radio stations that GPTC operates pursuant to management agreements: Stations WNGH (FM), Chatsworth and WATY (FM), Folkston. None of these stations has five or more employees, and therefore, GPTC has prepared a combined report for all these stations.¹

GPTC operates its radio and television stations as state public broadcast networks, with all the television programs originating in Atlanta and simulcast by all of the stations in the network. Most of the radio stations are operated in a similar manner, although some originate some programming locally. Given this structure, the bulk of GPTC's employees are located at its Atlanta headquarters. The employees at the individual stations are primarily technical personnel assigned to assure the proper operation of the stations.

While GPTC has employees throughout the state, it operates as a single agency for recruitment purposes and employs the same recruitment sources and employment initiatives for all of its job openings. GPTC is also an agency of the state of Georgia and its recruitment and employment practices are subject to the requirements of the State Personnel Administration, Georgia's equivalent of the federal civil service system.

- (v) Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

Georgia Public Broadcasting's internship program continues to expand by building relationships with local schools, colleges, universities and organizations to attract and target graduate and undergraduate students that have an interest in broadcast employment. The organization attended Georgia State University Best Practices for Internship Program conference to continue to look for ways to revamp and reinstitute our initiative to create a diverse group of internship opportunities. Currently GPB rotates students quarterly and year round to all operational areas to include Television, Field Productions, Information Technology, New Media, Education, Radio, Marketing and Communications, Original Programming/Creative Services, Development, Fundraising, Finance and Administration. Interns continue to receive hands on training and experience that allow them to acquire the necessary skills needed for administrative and broadcast level employment.

Georgia Public Broadcasting also actively extends ongoing opportunities for Volunteers through the efforts of the organization's Volunteer Coordinator for events and fund-raising campaigns.

- (vii) Participation in scholarship/educational stipend programs designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting.

Georgia Public Broadcasting has participated in scholarship and educational stipend programs in the past and continues to explore partnerships with local schools. In 2010 and 2011, GPB participated with the Year-up program which offers an intensive one year training program that provides urban young adults 18-24, with a unique opportunity to gain a combination of technical and professional skills. It also provides college credits, an educational stipend and corporate internships that allow students to gain knowledge and within the field of broadcasting and technology. GPB had two students to participate in this program gaining experience about technology and the components that connect technology and the broadcasting and production arena.

- (viii) Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for a higher-level position.

Through the Human Resources Office, Georgia Public Broadcasting continues to develop, coordinate, and provide ongoing in-house training as well as training that is outsourced to public and private vendors, to provide employees with additional skills to perform job responsibilities and to obtain higher-level responsibilities or positions. Some areas of training include:

- Broadcast Engineering Training for staff designed to broaden skills necessary to ensure compliance with media standards in the production, engineering and technical areas.
- The Effects of Change Workshop provided by the Employee Assistance Program to bring awareness of workplace and work life balance challenges and issues and how to adapt to changing times with high demands.
- EEOC Training for human resources staff on workplace diversity, employment laws and handling discriminations charges and complaints that may arise.

- UGA Government Accounting Series for accounting staff designed to keep abreast of accounting procedures and certification needed for job responsibility compliance in the area of Finance.
 - Automated Time and Attendance Training for HR Staff to explore efficient ways of recording employee's time and documenting leave and absence history for managers and subordinates.
- (x) Participation in at least four events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to career opportunities in broadcasting.

(v) Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

Georgia Public Broadcasting's internship program continues to expand by building relationships with local schools, colleges, universities and organizations to attract and target graduate and undergraduate students that have an interest in broadcast employment. The organization attended Georgia State University Best Practices for Internship Program conference to continue to look for ways to revamp and reinstitute our initiative to create a diverse group of internship opportunities. Currently GPB rotates students quarterly and year round to all operational areas to include Television, Field Productions, Information Technology, New Media, Education, Radio, Marketing and Communications, Original Programming/Creative Services, Development, Fundraising, Finance and Administration. Interns continue to receive hands on training and experience that allow them to acquire the necessary skills needed for administrative and broadcast level employment.

Georgia Public Broadcasting also actively extends ongoing opportunities for Volunteers through the efforts of the organization's Volunteer Coordinator for events and fund-raising campaigns.

(vii) Participation in scholarship/educational stipend programs designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting.

Georgia Public Broadcasting has participated in scholarship and educational stipend programs in the past and continues to explore partnerships with local schools. In 2010 and 2011, GPB participated with the Year-up program which offers an intensive one year training program that provides urban young adults 18-24, with a unique opportunity to gain a combination of technical and professional skills. It also provides college credits, an educational stipend and corporate internships that allow students to gain knowledge and within the field of broadcasting and technology. GPB had two students to participate in this program gaining experience about technology and the components that connect technology and the broadcasting and production arena.

(viii) Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for a higher-level position.

Through the Human Resources Office, Georgia Public Broadcasting continues to develop, coordinate, and provide ongoing in-house training as well as training that is outsourced to public and private vendors, to provide employees with additional skills to perform job responsibilities and to obtain higher-level responsibilities or positions. Some areas of training include:

- **Broadcast Engineering Training** for staff designed to broaden skills necessary to ensure compliance with media standards in the production, engineering and technical areas.

- **The Effects of Change Workshop** provided by the Employee Assistance Program to bring awareness of workplace and work life balance challenges and issues and how to adapt to changing times with high demands.
- **EEOC Training** for human resources staff on workplace diversity, employment laws and handling discriminations charges and complaints that may arise.
- **UGA Government Accounting Series** for accounting staff designed to keep abreast of accounting procedures and certification needed for job responsibility compliance in the area of Finance.
- **Automated Time and Attendance Training** for HR Staff to explore efficient ways of recording employee's time and documenting leave and absence history for managers and subordinates.

(x) Participation in at least four events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to career opportunities in broadcasting.

Each year Georgia Public Broadcasting participates in at least four job fair/career day events sponsored by educational institutions designed to promote and encourage career opportunities in broadcasting. Some of these events for the 2012 calendar year include:
