- **Consumer/Economy** – Saving money and avoiding scams is important to our viewers so we have dedicated one reporter to follow these issues exclusively.
- **Issues Affecting Children/Families** – The challenges faced by children, teens, and their parents in dealing with family/school/societal issues.
- **Commitment (Pol/Election)** – As elections happen, we provide coverage to help viewers make informed decisions.
- **State of Addiction** – Efforts to combat the opioid addiction problem are highlighted in a special series focused on the State of Addiction.
- **CommUNITY (CommU)** – Stories that focus on inclusion of marginalized members of the community.
