

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE
MASTER AGREEMENT
BY AND BETWEEN
SINCLAIR BROADCAST GROUP, INC.,
AND ITS SUBSIDIARIES,
AND
CUNNINGHAM BROADCASTING CORPORATION,
AND ITS SUBSIDIARIES**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT (this "Amendment"), dated July 20, 2010, by and between the signatories hereto, to the Master Agreement entered into on October 28, 2009, by and between Sinclair Broadcast Group, Inc., and its subsidiaries ("SBG"), and Cunningham Broadcasting Corporation ("CBC").

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Master Agreement in order to add a clarifying subsection to the Master Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 3 of the Master Agreement shall be amended by adding a new Section 3(b)(iii) as follows:

"(iii) In the event SBG desires to extend the terms of the LMAs for any Renewal Term as provided by Section 3(b)(i) of this Agreement, SBG shall give CBC notice of its intent to extend in accordance with Section 6(b) of this Agreement no later than twelve (12) months prior to the expiration of the current term or any Renewal Term."

2. This Amendment shall be effective as of the date first above written and shall not effect or impair the remainder of the terms and provisions of the Master Agreement which shall continue in full force and effect without modification thereto.


