Re: Election of Retransmission Consent

Dear Mr. Norton:

This letter is a notification that the television stations listed on Attachment A (“Stations”), owned and operated by Fox Television Holdings, LLC (“FTH”), elect retransmission consent with respect to retransmission of their broadcast signals by Americas Center Holdings, LLC or its affiliates (“Operator”). This retransmission consent election is for all communities within each of the Station’s applicable “television market” (as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 76.55(e)) served by cable systems and/or other video distribution systems owned or managed by or affiliated with Operator and any other system, community or headend for which Stations could elect must carry under the Rules referenced below.

Accordingly, Stations hereby notify Operator that, pursuant to Section 325(b)(3)(B) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the “Act”), and Section 76.64(f)(2) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (the “Rules”), Stations elect to assert their rights under Section 325(b)(1)(A) of the Act and Section 76.64(a) of the Rules to require that Operator obtain FTH’s express consent before retransmitting any of the Stations’ signals. This election of retransmission consent is for the period January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020.
