Re: Election of Retransmission Consent

Dear Ms. Ostler:

This letter is in response to your October 7, 2019 letter notifying New World Communications of Atlanta, Inc. ("NWC Atlanta") that Rodeo Networks ("Operator") intends to begin providing cable television service in the Atlanta DMA. Television station WAGA-TV, Atlanta, GA ("Station"), elects retransmission consent with respect to retransmission of its broadcast signal by Operator. This election is for any headend located in or around any and all communities serving the Atlanta DMA.

Accordingly, Station hereby notifies Operator that, pursuant to Section 325(b)(3)(B) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "ACT"), and Section 76.64(f)(2) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (the "Rules"), Station elects to assert its rights under section 325(b)(1)(A) of the Act and Section 76.64(a) of the Rules to require that Operator obtain Station's express consent before retransmitting its signal (which consent is not granted herein). This election of retransmission consent is for the current cycle through December 31, 2020.

To the extent that Operator does not qualify as an "MVPD" as defined by the FCC as of the date hereof, NWC Atlanta has no obligation to provide Operator with a notice of a must-carry or retransmission consent election and has no obligation to negotiate in good faith. Nothing contained herein shall be allowed to constitute a waiver of, or forbearance from the exercise of, any of NWC Atlanta's rights and remedies.
