TITLE: "Health Reports"
DATES: July 1 – September 30, 2009
TIMES: 5:00-5:30 p.m.
LENGTH: 45 seconds, 1:30 minutes
DESCRIPTION: Various news reports relating to health and fitness.

TITLE: "Oprah Winfrey Show " – "Dr. Oz Investigates Medical Mysteries"
DATE: Tuesday, July 28, 2009
TIME: 4:00 - 5:00 p.m.
LENGTH: 60 minutes
DESCRIPTION: Dr. Oz takes a look at medical mysteries on today's show. First guest is a 12 year old boy who is 7' 3"; next guest is 26 year old Kristen Riley. She is one of the oldest living primordial dwarfs. It's a condition that affects only 100 people on the planet. She shares the challenges she faces at only 39" tall. Another guest shares that she remembers almost every detail of her life for the past 30 years and why it's a curse and a blessing.

TITLE: "Oprah Winfrey Show" – "Released From Prison After Killing Her Father"
DATE: Thursday, July 16, 2009
TIME: 4:00 - 5:00 p.m.
LENGTH: 60 minutes
DESCRIPTION: On today's show two women admit to killing their loved ones. A wife of 24 years, just months away from facing a jury who will decide her fate, explains why she shot and killed her police officer husband, in what she claims was self defense. Next, a woman who spent 18 years in prison for killing her father tells why a governor commuted her life sentence and how she is handling her new found freedom.

TITLE: "Dr. Phil" – "One Mistake Away From Jail"

Another guest 19 year old Brett has a bright future, but his mother fears his drinking and driving will ruin his life or someone else's. He already has two DUI's and crashed three cars.

TITLE: "Dr Phil" – "Caught In The System"
DATE: Wednesday, August 19, 2009
TIME: 3:00 - 4:00 p.m.
LENGTH: 60 minutes
DESCRIPTION: There are over half a million kids in foster care, many are neglected and unloved children viewed as a paycheck by their new family. Dr. Phil takes a hard look at the realities these kids face and how the system is failing them. Jessica, 24, bounced from one home to another for six years. Her childhood was so unspeakable she witnessed the murder of her 5 year old sister at the hands of her mother and step-father.
